There is an abundance of wild life at Cobbleacre. As well as the usual birds and animals, you are likely to see, Deer, Foxes, Owls, Kingfishers, Kestrels, and Woodpeckers, (Badgers have been sighted but extremely rare maybe you'll be lucky).

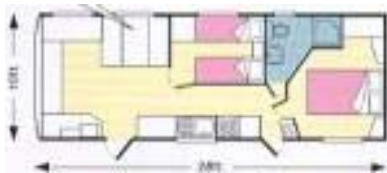
Visitors who are not anglers, and are looking for a quiet base from which to explore our tranquil piece of the English countryside are most welcome.

# Your Holiday Accommodation

Accommodation consists of 7 fully equipped Static caravans, all situated within a short distance of our 6 lakes. The caravans boast lovely views of the lakes and countryside.

Each unit has hot & cold water with a fully equipped kitchen, gas oven, grill, 4 way hob and fridge. They all have a bathroom, with shower, washbasin and flush toilet. The lounge and dining areas are comfortable and spacious and have a gas fire and colour TV. All caravans have an extra sleeping area (Double bed) in the lounge area, should it be required.

# The Lakes

## Mario's

Mario's lake is the jewel within our crown, it is a beautiful mature 3.5 acre lake with depths ranging from 5-13 feet. Fish stocks include 70+ twenty pound carp, 6+ thirty pound carp, along with 10+ twenty pound catfish and 3 thirty pound cats reaching a venue record of 35lb+. The lake contains thirty pound commons, mirrors, leathers and ghosties. These fish are in A1 condition and fight hard in the lakes deep margins. If you want to beat your personal best or just catch big fish in peaceful settings then this is the lake for you.

## Adams

Adams lake is for the carp angler who likes to get a run, the lake contains no less than 200+ double figure carp along with another 300 up and coming young fish as part of our continual management and stocking plan all within 2.5 acres! Adams lake also contains carp to well over twenty pounds so the fish of a lifetime is always on the cards. Other stocks include large bream to 13lb, tench to 10lb+ along with a variety of silver fish.

## Match lakes

These lakes can be fished on a day ticket at any time except when matches are on.

Gianna's lake is around 2 acres and is our silver fish match lake containing prolific stocks of roach, rudd, ide, crucian carp, tench, bream, large perch (5lb+) and a few large wily old carp to 20lb+. Catch this lake in the right mood and a huge net is most definitely on the cards. Amy's lake is targeted at the match carp anglers it is around 3 acres in size and contains large numbers of carp between 3-7lb average but they do run into double figures. Other stocks include a prolific head of tench, perch, roach, rudd along with chub, barbel and ide. This lake can offer a great days fishing with all features a comfortable distances within pole reach.

## Alex's

This is our fun pool, it's around ¼ acre and offers fabulous fishing. You are likely to catch many different species within this lake. It holds prolific head of carp to 17lb+ but averaging 5lb, crucians (3lb+), large head of tench, roach, rudd, perch etc. This little pool is a great place to spend a day or evenings fishing for all the family.



All lakes are between 50 and 300 metres from the caravans with parking available along many of them to allow easy access to the water and a short distance to walk.

## **Aylsham**

Small market town, Banks, Cash points, Indian/Chinese/Fish & Chips/Kebab restaurants, Post office, Newsagents, Bure valley railway.

Both are very popular tourist destinations and offer pubs, Cafes, restaurants, swimming pools, Shire horse centre, and the famous North Norfolk Steam Railway. Blakeney point boasts some of the most unspoilt salt marshes in Europe and large seal colonies that can be visited via the many seal trips.

Pleasure beach, Yarmouth greyhound & car racing stadium, Yarmouth race course, Port, Sea front shows, children's fun park, Sea life centre, reptile land, butterfly world, cinemas. (50 minute drive from Cobbleacre)

## **Lowestoft**

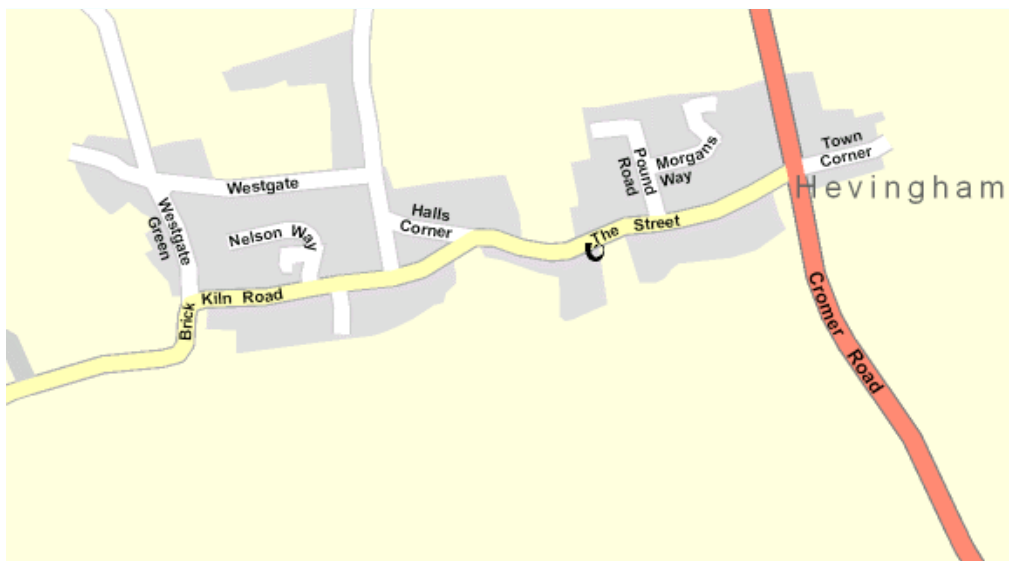
Pleasurewood hills theme park, fishing port. (1 hour 15 minutes)

# How To Find Us

## From Norwich

Head for the A140 (past Norwich Airport) towards Cromer and Aylsham.

Pass the Airport on your right and continue on the A140 towards Aylsham and Cromer for approximately 7 miles. You will see a sign for Hevingham village on your left hand side and then a pub called 'The Fox' on your right, take an immediate left after the pub down 'The Street'. Follow this road for approximately 800 yards and then take your first left onto 'Brick Kiln Road'. Follow the road and round the 'S' bend. The lakes are on the left approx 100 yards, look out for the sign. Follow the drive through the big white gates and carry on until you come to the Tackle shop.
